## Materials

### **Steel**

Iron and carbon alloy, with carbon content below 2%, treated to withstand the elements with the unique EMU-Coat anti-corrosio process.

**Maintenance:** To keep the product in good condition for a long time, we recommend storing it indoors and in a dry place during the winter to prevent condensate from forming.
